ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, (Not for Profit)

The undersigned, being natural persons over eighteen years of age, pursuant to Chapter 617.0202 of the Florida Statutes, set forth the following Articles of Incorporation:

NAME

The name of the corporation is Christian Research & Counsel, Inc.

PRINCIPLE OFFICE

The principle place of business and mailing address of the corporation is: 3500 12th Âv Ñ, St Petersburg FL 33713-6019

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), including, but not limited to, Providing Educational material and counsel to families victimized by false religions, educating the Christian church at large about false religions and equipping them to defend their faith, intervening between proselytizing false religions and their prospective converts, exposing and comparing the (usually hidden) beliefs of the false religion to Biblical Christianity, enabling the investigator to make an informed decision, and educating members of false religions about the errors which prevent them from realizing their rightful relationship to God through Jesus Christ.

MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATION

The Corporation shall have members. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the board of directors. The number of the directors shall be fixed by the bylaws of the corporation, but may not be less than three (3).

NET EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the tax-exempt purposes of the corporation set forth in Article 3.

The corporation shall have a racially nondiscriminatory policy and therefore shall not discriminate against applicants, students, employees, and others on the basis of race, color, or national or ethnic origin.

ARTICLE 10 TRANSFER OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, transfer all assets to a fund, foundation, or organization which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes and at that time qualifies as an organization exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE 11 LIMITATIONS ON CORPORATE ACTIVITIES

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
