ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR MID FLORIDA RACING, INC.

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of Mid Florida Racing, Inc. under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, and Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, submits the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is: Mid Florida Racing, Inc.

ARTICLE II. ADDRESS

The address of the corporation's principal office is 2280 N. Prairie Industrial Pkwy., Mulberry, Florida 33860-9621.

ARTICLE III. DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT

The Corporation will exist perpetually, commencing with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

To provide assistance with sponsoring certain organized racing programs.

The purposes of the corporation shall also include the performance of activities related or incidental to the furtherance of the corporation's stated purposes and permitted under the laws of the United States and Florida.

ARTICLE V. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

This corporation shall not engage in any activities prohibited by Section 617.0835 of the Florida Statutes.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE VI. DIRECTORS

The initial board of directors of the Corporation shall consist of three members. The names and addresses of the members of the Corporation's initial board of directors are:

The method of election of directors shall be as stated in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VII. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 2280 N. Prairie Industrial Pkwy., Mulberry, Florida 33860-9621, and the Corporation's initial registered agent at that address is Suzanne McCoy.

ARTICLE VIII. INCORPORATOR

The name and street address of the incorporator is Alan McCoy, 2280 N. Prairie Industrial Pkwy., Mulberry, Florida 33860-9621. The incorporator of the Corporation assigns to the Corporation his rights under Section 617.013, Florida Statutes, to constitute a corporation.

ARTICLE IX. DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, the residual assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to one or more organizations that themselves are exempt from federal income taxation as organizations described within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court for the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. No part of the assets or net earnings of the corporation may be distributed or inure to the benefit of any individual.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENTS

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner prescribed by law.
