ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: SWMRK Organization Incorporated.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 2807 N.W. 68th Avenue, Gainesville, FL 32605

ARTICLE III. DURATION

The duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSES

This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation are to:

- a) provide various types and levels of cooperative support, assistance, relief, encouragement, opportunity, and training for those single, custodial parents who have middle school age children, and on behalf also of their middle school age children;
- b) support single, custodial parents in their efforts to meet the scholastic, academic, life experience, skills, and social interaction needs of their middle school age children;
- c) organize single, custodial parents of middle-school age children, and their children, for self-help and to schedule events, meetings, trips, training, monitoring, mentoring, transportation, or other functions to cooperatively dispense services and resources in the furtherance of a) and b) above; and
- d) any other lawful purpose or act, not for the pecuniary profit of an individual member, including, but not limited to, those powers and authorities set forth in 607.0301, 607.0302, and 607.0303, F.S., as they now provide, or may hereafter be amended to provide, and other general powers not specifically prohibited to corporations and/or nonprofit corporations under the laws of Florida; provided, however, that the corporation shall not have the power or authority to engage in any action or activity which is not permitted to be carried on by a nonprofit, tax exempt corporation under the Internal Revenue Code, and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but provided further that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to members, directors, or officers for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in the furtherance of its above-stated charitable, benevolent, educational, social, and eleemosynary purposes.

ARTICLE V. MANNER OF QUALIFYING FOR MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have voting Parent Member, non-voting Child Member, and non-voting Interested Party Associate Member classes of membership, who shall each make application for membership to the Board of Directors, or its designees, and may be accepted if they meet the membership qualifications and pay the dues, charges, and other assessments required for their applicable class of membership. Such memberships may also be revoked as to a member of any class whom the Board of Directors, or its designee(s), deems no longer meeting the qualifications for membership as provided and in the manner set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation. The Bylaws shall provide the requirements and criteria for each member class that may be admitted into the organization, and shall have such rights and privileges, as are set forth in the Bylaws. The voting Parent Members on the membership rolls shall elect the Directors of the Corporation at the time of election. The names and addresses of each initial voting Parent Member are as follows:
