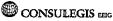

## CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SEABREEZE AT ATLANTIC VIEW CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned officers of Seabreeze At Atlantic View Condominium Association, Inc. do hereby certify that the following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation are a true and correct copy as amended, pursuant to Article 12 thereof, by the membership at a duly called and noticed meeting of the members held **March 10, 2003** and by the Board of Directors at a duly called and noticed meeting of the Board of Directors held **March 20, 2003**. The amendments were adopted by the members and the Board of Directors and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

#### AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SEABREEZE AT ATLANTIC VIEW CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

#### **ARTICLE 4**

#### **POWERS**

The powers of the Association shall include and be governed by the following:

4.2 Enumeration. The Association shall have all of the powers and duties set forth in the Act, and all of the powers and duties reasonably necessary to operate the Condominium pursuant to the Declaration and as more particularly described in the By-Laws, as they may be amended from time to time, including, but not limited to, the following:

(h) To contract for the management and maintenance of the Condominium Property and to authorize a management agent which may be an affiliate of Developer) to assist the Association in carrying out its powers and duties by performing such functions as the submission of proposals, collection of Assessments, preparation of records, enforcement of rules and maintenance, repair and replacement of the Common Elements with such funds as shall be made available by the Association for such purposes. The Association and its officers shall, however, retain at all times the powers and duties granted by the Condominium Act, including, but not limited to, the making of Assessments, promulgation of rules and execution of contracts on behalf of the Association.

#### **ARTICLE 8**

#### **OFFICERS**

The affairs of the Association shall be administered by the officers holding the offices designated in the By-Laws. The officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors of the Association at its first meeting following the annual meeting of the members of the Association and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors. The By-Laws may

provide for the removal from office of officers, for filling vacancies and for the duties and qualifications of the officers. The names and addresses of the officers who shall serve until their successors are designated by the Board of Directors are as follows:

#### ARTICLE 9

#### DIRECTORS

9.1 Number and Qualification. The property, business and affairs of the Association shall be managed by a board consisting of the number of directors determined in the manner provided by set forth in the By-Laws., but which shall consist of not less than three (3) Directors. Directors, other than designees of Developer, must be members of the Association. Directors must be members of the Association or the spouse or live-in companion of a member of the Association.

- 9.4 Term of Developer's Directors. Developer of the Condominium shall appoint the members of the first Board of Directors and their replacements who shall held office for the periods described in the By-Laws.

#### **ARTICLE 12**

#### **AMENDMENTS**

\* \* \*

- 12.2 Adoption. A resolution for the adoption of a proposed amendment may be proposed either by a majority of the Board of Directors or by not less than one-third (1/3) of the members of the Association. Directors and members not present in person or by proxy at the meeting considering the amendment may express their approval in writing, provided that such approval is delivered to the Secretary at or prior to the meeting. Votes to amend the Articles of Incorporation may also be conducted by written consent in lieu of a meeting. The approval must be by not less than a majority of the votes of all members of the Association present and voting, in person or by proxy, at a meeting at which a quorum is established, or, if the vote is by written consent, by a majority of consents received as of the sixtieth (60th) day from the date the first written consent is received, provided the written consents received constitute a quorum.
- (a) by not less than a majority of the votes of all members of the Association represented at a meeting at which a quorum thereof has been attained and by not less than 66-23% of the entire Board of Directors; or
  - (b) by not-less than 100% of the entire Board of Directors.
- 12.4 Developer Amendments. To the extent-lawful, the Developer may amend these Articles consistent with the provisions of the Declaration allowing certain amendments to be effected by the Developer alone.
- 42.5 12.4 Recording. A copy of each amendment shall be filed with the Secretary of State pursuant to the provisions of applicable Florida law, and a copy certified by the Secretary of State shall be recorded in the public records of St. Lucie County, Florida.
