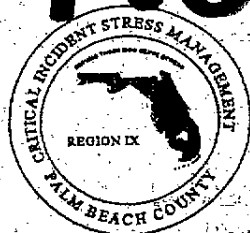

Article III Purposes

Section 3

The third mission of the Critical Incident Stress Management Team of Palm Beach County, Inc.

- A. This organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.**
- B. No part of the net earnings of the Corporations shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer of the Corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation), and no officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation.**
- C. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Code), or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statement), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.**
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the organization not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by an organization whose contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).**
- E. Upon dissolution of this organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of th Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principle office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.**
