Articles of Incorporation of Central Directions, Inc. (A Not for Profit Corporation)

Article I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Central Directions, Inc.

Article II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

524 W. 3rd. St. Jacksonville, FL 32209


Article III. PURPOSE

The organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and/or scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Specifically, the corporation will:

- a). Provide after school tutoring and recreational services to youth in the community.
- b). Provide meals to homeless and indigent in the community.
- c). Provide rehabilitation counseling to those affected by substance abuse.
- d). Provide these services to the general public, with particular focus on those with limited financial resources.

Article IV. MANNER OF ELECTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall range in number from a minimum of 3, to a maximum of 11, such maximum which can be changed pursuant to the by-laws of the corporation. The Board of Directors shall be appointed by the President, through written communication and acceptance, and ratified by a majority vote of sitting Board members. Board members shall serve annually. The President shall be the Pastor of the affiliated church, Central Baptist Institutional Church.

Article V. LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, ore (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article VI. DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
