## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

## DE-SAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENTAL LEARNING CENTER, INC

ARTICLE I:

The name of the corporation shall be **DE-SAN Community Developmental Learning Center, Inc.** This corporation is organized pursuant to the FLORIDA Non-Profit Corporation Codes.

ARTICLE II:

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 500 59th Street, West Palm Beach, FL 33407.

ARTICLE III:

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is as follows: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and no part of any net earnings shall ensure to the benefit of any private member. There will be several Community Services Programs organized to operate through this nonprofit Corporation. They are as follows: (1) **D-SCDC - DE-SAN Child Development Center** providing quality/professional childcare and an unconditional commitment to the children and parents in direct support of strengthening the family and single parents;

(2) **ASCTC/YSCE** - After School Care & Tutorial/Youth Summer Camp Extravaganza (ages 5 to 17) - providing adult supervisory care for working parents and academic tutorial programs in order for students to excel to their fullest potential academically while in school .

Summer Youth Camp Extravaganza - providing adult supervision for the working parent(s). As well as, providing multi-cultural learning experiences for our youth. This program will provide support services for community businesses and organizations in direct support of students at risk to build self esteem, self guidance, provide mentoring for adolescent girls and boys, and broaden youth horizons. In efforts to curtail adolescent truancy in the community.

- (3) **TEPPI-** Transportation for the Elderly & Programs of Interest providing transportation for the elderly to appointments, senior citizens programs of interest at various senior citizens centers, sight-seeing, community meetings and/or community outing's, parks of interest and fun and entertainment during normal working hours.
- (4) *T/APE* Teen/Adult Parent Enrichment providing teen/adult parenting sessions to become successful and productive individuals in society; (5) *CDA/NAEYC Certification Courses* -

providing educational training for those interested in becoming child development associates (teachers). These courses will be designed and/or coordinated according to state and national requirements and guidelines, in order to empower and ensure individuals quality child care knowledge and skills (hands-on experience) to obtain their NATIONAL ASSOCIATION for the EDUCATION OF YOUNG CHILDREN (NAEYC) Certificate; and (6) AMP- Anger Management Program - providing individuals with professional methods and techniques in how to control and conduct themselves at home, school, the workplace, as well as everyday situations faced with in life.

#### ARTICLE IV:

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows: The Board of Directors will serve a one year term. Each director shall hold office authority to appoint other staff personnel as needed. In the event that an official position is vacated, the Board shall appoint a temporary replacement for the position until an official election can be conducted. The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in **Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes**, unless limited shall be as follows: The property of this corporation irrevocably dedicated

to Charitable and Educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever ensure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or the benefit of any private person. On dissolution of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for Charitable and Educational Programs under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Services Code. The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, no stock and shall have no members.

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Educational and Charitable purposes within the meaning of Section (501) (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activity not permitted (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code; (2) by a corporation contribution's to which are deductible under Section 170 (C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
