A Florida Nonprofit Corporation

Article I - Name

Article II – Non-Profit

This corporation is a non-profit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act for religious purposes.

Article III - Principal Address

Article IV - Commencement

This corporation shall commence on the date of execution and acknowledgment of these Articles.

Article V - Purpose

This corporation is organized for the purpose of providing a mission to the needy, the homeless, the impoverished in spirit and wealth, and the children of God; and to minister to the religious needs of such persons in accordance with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and the Word of God through financial support of productive activities and projects.

these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.


