

### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

# FAITH CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP OF CENTRAL BREVARD, INC.

# KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under the laws of the State of FLORIDA, do hereby certify:

### ARTICLE ONE

The name of said corporation shall be FAITH CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP OF CENTRAL BREVARD, INC., and the duration shall be perpetual. Upon disaffiliation with Faith Christian Fellowship International Church, Inc. the right to use this name shall cease immediately and a name change shall be effected.

## ARTICLE TWO

The name and address of the registered agent in the State of Florida is Rick Robertson at 869 Pinewood Ave., Rockledge, Florida, 32955, County of Brevard, his signature, infra at page five, indicates his acceptance of this designation. The address of the corporations Registered and Principal office in the State of Florida is 869 Pinewood Ave., Rockledge, Florida, 32955, County of Brevard.



### ARTICLE THREE

This organization is organized and operated exclusively for exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended including the following purposes:

- (a) Religious.
- (b) To conduct a local church by the direction of the Lord, Jesus Christ and under the leadership of the Holy Spirit in accordance with all of the commandments and provisions as set forth in the Holy Bible.
  - (c) Minister the Word of God to the faithful.
- (d) Conduct a religious worship service through various forms of ministry.
- (e) Promote and encourage, through the ministry of the organization, cooperation with other organizations ministering within the community.
- (f) Spread the Word of the Gospel through seminars, radio and other forms of mass media for the purpose of educating the individual in the Word of God.
- (g) To acquire and hold such property, either real or personal, for Church purposes, as may be necessary for its membership in the worship of God.
  - (h) To establish and operate a Christian school.

# ARTICLE FOUR

To assure the corporation of its sovereignty and independence and to perpetually protect the church, all ecclesiastical and legal power and authority relative to the corporation shall be exercised by and in accordance with the New Testament Church pattern. Thus under the leadership of the Holy Spirit the Board of Trustees shall conduct all the business of the corporation (church) and shall be the only voting members of the corporation (church). The number of Trustees, and their qualifications shall be established in the Bylaws of this corporation. The qualifications of members and the manner of their admission shall be fully provided in the Bylaws.

### **ARTICLE FIVE**

This nonprofit corporation is formed without any purpose of pecuniary profit and shall have no capital stock.

### ARTICLE SIX

The private property of the trustees and members shall be non-assessable and shall not be subject to the payment of any corporate debts, nor shall the trustees or members of the corporation become individually or corporately liable or responsible for any debts or liabilities of the corporation.

### ARTICLE SEVEN

(a) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable

to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in ARTICLE III hereof.

- (b) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
  - (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any

other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

(d) Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The assets shall be disbursed in the following order of priority: first to FAITH CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP INTERNATIONAL CHURCH, INC. (FCF International) located in Tulsa, Oklahoma. If FCF International chooses not to receive the assets they shall be distributed to a 501(c)(3) organization as chosen by the Board of Trustees of FCF International. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose by the court of jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine

## ARTICLE EIGHT

These Articles may be amended at any regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, or at a special meeting called for that purpose, by a two-thirds (2/3) majority.

# ARTICLE NINE

The undersigned incorporators shall act as the initial Board of Trustees until their successors shall have been duly qualified and elected. The Trustees shall be elected yearly at the annual business meeting by the voting members. The initial Board of Directors shall not be less than three (3). The undersigned shall hold the offices indicated.
