### ARTICLES OF INCÒRPORATION OF

The undersigned does hereby execute, acknowledge and file the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of creating a not for profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE I

The name of this not for profit corporation shall be:

THE LIBERTY FUNDAMENTAL SCHOOL OF PASCO COUNTY, INC.

#### ARTICLE II

This not for profit corporation shall commence its perpetual existence on the date these Articles are filed with the Secretary of State.

#### ARTICLE III

The general purpose for which this not for profit corporation is organized is to establish and operate a not for profit charter school[s]. For these purposes this corporation may engage in any activity and exercise any power or authority that may be engaged in by a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as amended.

#### ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall issue no stock. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of or shall be distributed to its members, directors, or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities deemed impermissible for corporations exempt from

federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law. On the dissolution of this corporation the board of directors shall dispose of all assets of this corporation in the manner or to organizations that are organized and operated exclusively as exempt organizations under Section(s) 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law. or after paying or making provisions for the liabilities of this corporation. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of this corporation is the located. Such court of competent jurisdiction shall dispose of the assets of this corporation to organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes.


