ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE SALESIAN SOCIETY OF ST. PETERSBURG, INC. A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The name of this corporation is THE SALESIAN SOCIETY OF ST. PETERSBURG, INC., (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation).

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless it shall hereafter be dissolved according to law.

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial principal office of this corporation is 6470 - 13th Avenue North, St. Petersburg, Florida 33710, and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation is BROTHER WILLIAM J. HANNA, S.D.B., and the address of the registered agent is 6470 - 13th Avenue North, St. Petersburg, Florida 33710.

ARTICLE IV

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed, and the business and objectives to be carried out and promoted by it, are as follows:

- The corporation shall carry out the religious principles and tenets of The Salesians (A) of St. John Bosco (commonly called The Salesian Society), to establish a religious community within the geographic area of St. Petersburg, Florida.
- The corporation may exercise the powers permitted non-profit corporations under (B) Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes; provided, however, that this Corporation, in exercising any one or more of such powers shall do so in furtherance of the exempt purpose for which it has been organized as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

(C) The Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for non-profit purposes; and no part of the income or assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to, nor inure to the benefit of any individual.

ARTICLE V POWERS

The Corporation is empowered:

- (A) To buy, own, sell, convey, assign, mortgage or lease any interest in real estate and personal property, and to construct, maintain and operate improvements thereon necessary or incident to the accomplishment of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.
- (B) To borrow money and issue evidence of indebtedness in furtherance of any or all of the objects of its business, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, or other lien on the Corporation's property.
- (C) To do and perform all acts reasonably necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Corporation as permitted non-profit corporations under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.
- (D) In the event of dissolution, winding up, or other liquidation of the assets of this Corporation, the residual assets of the Corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any or future law, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.
- (E) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this Corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE VI DIRECTORS AND MEMBERS

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, consisting of not less than three (3) in number who shall be elected by the members of the Corporation at the Annual Meeting. The Directors of the Corporation must, at all times, be members of the Corporation. No

non-member of the Corporation may sit as a Director. The names and post office addresses of the persons who shall serve as initial Directors until their successors are duly qualified, are as follows:
