ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JMJ Home School Corporation A NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a Not for Profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and the general amendments thereto, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is JMJ Home School Corporation.

ARTICLE II

Principal Office

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: c/o St. Mary's Catholic Church, 15520 North Blvd Tampa, FL 33613 Mailing Address: c/o Jan Van Durme, 1336 Distant Oaks Drive, Wesley Chapel, FL 33543-5734.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

JMJ Home School Corporation is a volunteer support group for home school families in Pasco, Hillsborough Counties and surrounding areas. JMJ Home School Corporation believes educating at home is a viable educational alternative. Membership in JMJ Home School Corporation provides support, communication and educational opportunities, as well as the chance to meet and fellowship with other home educators. While founded upon and committed to Biblical principles, JMJ Home School Corporation welcomes home educators of all faiths who support: Educational excellence; parental authority and responsibility for education; protection and promotion of traditional families; diligence in training and development of character and freedom of choice among educational alternatives. Further any and all lawful business as provided by Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes and Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

The purpose for which JMJ Home School Corporation is organized are exclusively

religious, charitable, and/or educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV

Manner of Election

The corporation shall have members, which may be divided into such classes as shall be provided in the bylaws. All members shall be accepted, appointed, elected or designated in the manner provided in the bylaws.

The directors of the corporation shall be elected or appointed in the manner and for the terms provided in the Bylaws.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director or member of the corporation; and upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of the residual assets of the corporation exclusively for the stated purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding Sections of any future Internal Revenue Code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, for such purposes or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
