ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

SECRETARY OF STATE
FLORIDA WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FINANCING CORPORA-FROM, SSEE, FLORIDA
A Florida Not For Profit Corporation

The undersigned Incorporator hereby makes and files these Articles of Incorporation on behalf of the Florida Water Pollution Control Financing Corporation (the "Corporation"), pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, stating as follows:

- The name of the Corporation shall be the Florida Water Pollution
 Control Financing Corporation, and is hereby organized as a Florida not for profit
 Corporation, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.
- 2. The date and time of the commencement of its corporate existence shall be the 11th day of September, 2000. The Corporation shall terminate upon fulfillment of the statutory purposes of the Corporation as set forth in Section 403.1837, Florida Statutes.
 - 3. The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is as follows:
- (a) To provide for financing or refinancing the costs of water pollution control projects and activities described in Section 403.1835, Florida Statutes.
- (b) To borrow money and issue bonds, notes, certificates of indebtedness or other obligations or evidences of indebtedness for the purpose of providing funds for projects and activities as provided in Section 403.1837(1), Florida Statutes, or for refunding bonds previously issued by the Corporation.

- (c) To acquire, in any manner, property, real, personal or mixed, and to assign the Corporation's interest under any and all financing transactions to a trustee or trustees, as security for holders of bonds or other forms of indebtedness of the Corporation issued or incurred for the purposes set forth herein in Section 403.1837, Florida Statutes.
- (d) To operate any program to provide financial assistance authorized under Section 403.1835(3), Florida Statutes, which may be funded from any funds received under a service contract with the Department of Environmental Protection, from proceeds of bonds issued by the Corporation, or any other funding sources obtained by the Corporation.
- (e) To participate in all forms of financing agreements, necessary or appropriate to the issuance of bonds or other forms of indebtedness by the Corporation for the purposes set forth herein and in Section 403.1837, Florida Statutes, including, but not limited to, contracts, trust or bond indentures, pledge or other security agreements, offering documents or statements, letters and lines of credit or any other agreements that are necessary and desirable to further the purposes of the Corporation.
- (f) To participate in all forms of service contracts with the Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to which the Corporation shall provide services to the Department of Environmental Protection in connection with financing the functions and activities provided for in Sections 403.1837, Florida Statutes.

- (g) To perform all other lawful acts and do any and other things authorized by law, including all matters and things authorized by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes and Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, to the extent not inconsistent with Chapter 617 and Section 403.1837, Florida Statutes.
- 4. As required by Section 403.1837(2), Florida Statutes, the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall consist of the Governor's Budget Director, or a designee, the Comptroller of the State of Florida, or a designee, the Treasurer of the State of Florida, or a designee, and the Secretary of the Department of Environmental Protection or a designee. The Governor's Budget Director, the Comptroller, the Treasurer and the Secretary of the Department of Environmental Protection shall be permitted to name, either permanently or temporarily, another person to attend meetings of the Board of Directors of the Corporation (collectively, the "Designees") which Designees shall have all power and authority of the member of the Board of Directors who shall have designated them. On January 7, 2003, the Chief Financial Officer of the State of Florida, or the Chief Financial Officer's designee shall take the place of the Treasurer and the Comptroller, or their designees, on the Corporation's Board of Directors. The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be self-perpetuating and not subject to direct appointment by any person, but rather shall always consist of the above-named officials or the Designees, as the case may be.
- 5. The street address of the Corporation's initial registered office, principal office and mailing address, and the name of its initial registered agent at

No shares of stock shall be issued, no dividends shall be paid, and no part of the income of the Corporation, if any, shall be distributed to its members, directors or officers. No payment, benefit, distribution or compensation of any kind shall be paid to the Corporation's directors, officers or members.
