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#### ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT In Compliance with Chapter 617.1006, F.S. (Not for Profit)

#### AMENDMENT, Article III, Purpose March 21, 2005

This amendment to HANDICAPPED ADULTS OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, INC., a Florida corporation, Article III, Purpose, entirely deletes the Article III, Purpose in the Original Articles of Incorporation and the subsequent Amendment to Article II (incorrectly numbered II instead of III), Purpose, filed on October 15, 2004 with the State of Florida, Division of Corporations.

This organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational or scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501 ©)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Handicapped Adults of Volusia County, Inc, is organized exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of section 501©)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The purpose of this corporation is to educate the disabled to their rights, to identify and work to overcome architectural, employment and other barriers to the disabled and to survey what services are needed for the physically challenged in Volusia County.

No part of the net earnings of organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth. Social activities will be insubstantial, less than four percent (4%) of the year and there will not be any organizational funds used for this purpose. There will be no recreational activities.

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be for the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Less than three percent (3%) of the organizational activities and zero organizational funds shall be to make members aware of those issues/legislation affecting the disabled population.

Notwithstanding, any other provision of these Articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on

- (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501©)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code or
- (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170©)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed to Easter Seals of Volusia County, Florida. The meaning of section 501 (©)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal

government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
