ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ASEAN ANIOS The name of the Corporation is Faith Covenant Academy, Inc. ARTICLE I. NAME

ARTICLE II. DURATION The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III. PRINCIPAL OFFICE The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is 820 S. Bridgestone Ave., Jacksonville, FL 32259.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSES The purpose of the corporation is as follows:

- A. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.
