ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F. S. , (Not for Profit)

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ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPLE OFFICE

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to provide a forum for scholarly professionals in the fields of English and Foreign Languages to convene annually and to present research findings in the form of scholarly papers in order to share and disseminate information concerning the profession of instructing college students.

ARTICLE IV: MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

Officers are elected each year to fill vacancies, consisting of a President, and two Vice-Presidents; nominations are solicited from the membership of the corporation via a newsletter. The year's Past-President remains a member of the Board of Directors for one year. The Board of Directors is made up of a variety of teaching professionals elected from within the membership, but their terms are staggered, so as to have some consistency from year-to-year. Also, the Executive Director is a member of this board; this position is a paid position, and the hiring is done through the organization; candidates for this position must be members of the corporation at-large.


