ANNUAL REPORT - YEAR 2005

A meeting was held on January 13, 2006 to review the activities of the Foundation in the year 2005.

- 1. Letters were sent to the American Cancer Society, American Society of Radiation Oncology, Cancer Society of Ghana in Africa, and Indian Cancer Society for their cooperation in helping the cancer patients.
- 2. P.P. Sinha, President of the Foundation, attended the annual conference of the Indian Organization of Radiation Oncology at Ahmedabad from December 1, 2005 to December 4, 2005.

Discussions and meetings were held in the matters of cancer education, treatment, and research, etc., in the areas where cancer treatment facilities are still unavailable. Although new cancer centers have emerged in the past several years in India, they are all in the urban areas, especially in the big cities. Local and national organizations are to be encouraged to come forward to open at least a few centers in the most backward areas. The president of the Association of Radiation Oncologists of India will approach such organizations for help and will review the outcomes at the next annual conference in November 2006.

- 3. Upon the request of an organization, Dr. Sinha visited the site of the proposed cancer center at Hazaribagh in Northeast India. This area is backward with a tribal population of almost 30 per cent. Dr. Sinha developed a blueprint and helped in making a future plan for the cancer center. It is a matter of great delight that the plan has been sent to the A.E.C.I. for approval. Once approved, it will take about a year to complete the building and start treating patients.
- 4. Several cancer patients were seen in the office of a local surgeon, Dr. H.L. Saha, at Hazaribagh. It was suggested by Dr. Saha to rent a small office and start helping the local population in the prevention and development of cancer by stopping smoking and drinking, etc.; by distributing literature, etc.; and also by lecturing in different local organizations. Dr. Sinha contributed \$1,000 to an organization, BIRSA SEWA SADAN (BIRSA SERVICE HOUSE) and promised to extend help in the future also.
- 5. Literature on cancer prevention will be obtained from the American Cancer Society and will be sent to Dr. Saha at Hazaribagh.
