ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with the requirements of Florida Statutes, Chapter 617 (1993), the undersigned, who is a resident of the State of Florida, and who is of full age, for the purpose of forming a Florida corporation not for profit, hereby certifies:

ARTICLE [

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation is COUNCIL FOR DIVERSITY IN PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS, INC., a Florida corporation not for profit (hereafter called the "Association").

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE ASSOCIATION

The principal office of the Association is located at C/O Weiss & Handler, P.A., 2255 Glades Road, Suite 218A, Boca Raton, Florida 33431.

ARTICLE III

REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

B. C. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
