**PRAYER, PRAISES, WORSHIP & DELIVERANCE CENTER, INC.**

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**BY THESE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION** the incorporators form a corporation not for profit under Florida law.

1. **NAME.** The name of this corporation is PRAYER, PRAISES, & WORSHIP, & DELIVERANCE CENTER, INC.

2. **PURPOSE.** The purpose for which this corporation is organized is educational, religious and charitable; specifically to form a church, including, but not limited to;

A. To provide a vehicle for the acquisition and/or management of radio and/or television broadcast stations for the dissemination of educational and /or religious bible materials, as well as the production and distribution of bible educational material utilizing those media.

B. The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, scientific or literary purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal Tax Laws, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax exempt organizations under that code.

Within the limitations of the intent of this subsection (B), this corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful non-profit business for which corporations may be incorporated under Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, as now exists or may after be amended.

3. **MEMBERS.** (a) The members of this corporation shall be admitted to membership by becoming a member of the church.

(b) Members of this corporation shall cease being a member of this corporation by ceasing to be a member of the church.

(c) This corporation shall issue no stock. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation. This corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law. On the dissolution of this corporation the board of directors shall dispose of all of the assets of this corporation exclusively for the purposes of this corporation in the manner or to the organization or organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes and that shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of this corporation. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of this corporation is then located exclusively for the purposes or to the organizations that the court determines are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or

scientific purposes.

4. TERM. This corporation shall exist perpetually.

8. BYLAWS. The bylaws of the corporation shall be adopted by the board of directors.

9. AMENDMENTS. An amendment to these articles may be proposed by the board of directors or a member. Amendments shall be adopted by the board of directors by the affirmative vote of at least three fourths of the directors present and voting at a meeting at which a quorum is present.

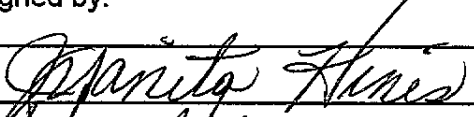

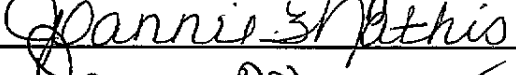
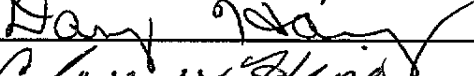
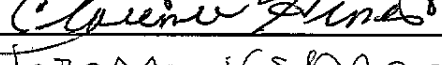
