ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FLORIDA DEEN INTENSIVE, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Not for Profit Corporation Act of the State of Florida, adopt the following Articles of incorporation:

The name of the corporation hereinafter referred to, as the "Corporation" is Florida Deen Intensive, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the Organization is perpetual. The principal mailing office will 3940 SW 121 Avenue Miami, FL 33175-3528

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to corporations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The Organization may receive and administer funds for religious, educational, and charitable purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and to that end, the corporation is empowered to hold any property, or any undivided interest therein, without limitation as to amount or value; to dispose of any such property and to invest, reinvest, or deal with the principal or the income in such manner as, in the judgment of the directors, will best promote the purposes of the Corporation, without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received, these Articles of Incorporation, the By-Laws of the Corporation, or any applicable laws, to do any other act or thing incidental to or connected with the foregoing purposes or in advancement thereof, but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain of its directors or officers except as permitted under the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, officer of the Corporation, or any private individual, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes, and no member, trustee, officer of the Corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in, including the publication or distribution of statements, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the Corporation shall be distributed exclusively to a not for profit corporation, Zaytuna Institute, located in Hayward California.

ARTICLE IV

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admissions shall be regulated by the constitution. At the first general body meeting in the October, the general body will nominate and elect the officers. The candidate with the most votes for each position will assume office. This first meeting will be organized by the ameer/a of the previous year. Terms for representatives and officers will last for two years.
