
Enclosed is the application for reinstatement along with a check for \$131.25, which includes the 2001 and 2002 fees of \$61.25 for each year plus a certificate of good standing for \$8.75.

We would like to state the original application that was mailed at the beginning of 2001 was never received by us. We moved from the original address (193 Corydon Drive, Miami Springs, FL 33166) and even though we left a forwarding address it was never forwarded to our new address (8125 S.W. 26 Street, Miami, FL 33155) nor was it ever returned to you.

Our corporation is *not* a business. We are a not-for profit entity created late in the year 2000 to raise funds to help families of political prisoners in Cuba who do not have the means to provide for the basic needs of life (food, shelter, etc...) while their relatives are serving time in prison for beliefs against the existing political regime. Their families are also deprived many times of the right to work while their relatives are in prison. Charging us a reinstatement fee would be a burden on us. Therefore, we request that you abate the reinstatement fee and accept the above check to reinstate us in good standing.

We formed the corporation on October 26, 2000, and were not aware of the annual fee required. Since we never received the renewal form, we were completely unaware of the requirement to pay the annual fee. Now we know and can assure you that this incident will not happen in the future and will inquire if we do not receive an annual renewal form at the beginning of each year.
