ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

OLD ANTARCTIC EXPLORERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- To stimulate and perpetuate love of country our Flag, support and appreciation for the service and sacrifices of all our Military Forces, past and present,
- To defend the honor, integrity, and supremacy of our national government and the Constitution of the United States,
- To support, develop, encourage, foster, and stimulate the continued exploration of Antarctica for the
 peaceful, scientific, and ecological benefits of all mankind. Advance, promote, sustain reasonable
 efforts to locate, identify, verify, collect, catalog, preserve artifacts and memorabilia pertaining and
 relating to the exploration of the ANTARCTIC, and
- To collect, record, illuminate oral, written, personal histories and sacrifices of Antarctic Explorers and honor those who gave their lives in that quest, and
- To aid past and present Antarctic Explorers from which our members are drawn, and their dependents
 and survivors in every proper and legitimate matter; and to provide social, recreational and fraternal
 contacts between its members, and
- To present the best interests and rights of Antarctic Explorers to proper authority when appropriate.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:.

Section I. A President and Executive Vice-President shall be elected annually by the majority present at the symposium to serve until the next annual symposium or until their successors are elected. The initial election for the Board of Directors will be two, three and four years respectively. Thereafter, the Directors will be elected to serve for three year terms.

Section II. A Treasurer shall be elected and a Secretary shall be appointed to serve until such time as a new Secretary and/or Treasurer is elected/appointed.

Section III. Elected offices of the OAEA will be held only by active members and Life members of the Association having all the privileges of membership including the right to vote and to hold office as defined by Article III provided no conflict of interest exists.

Section IV. On the first day of the symposium the President shall appoint tellers who shall act also as inspectors of elections.

Section V. Polls shall be open for such a period of time as shall be specified in advance by the Board of Directors.
