ARTCLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF TOMMORROWS GEMERATIONAL YOUTH RANCH MINSTRIES INCORPORATED

ARTICLE VII: States any other provisions notwithstanding of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE IX: Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state, or local government for a public purpose.
