

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF



CENTRO BIBLICO ELIMELEC, INC. (BIBLE STUDIES ELIMELEC, INC.)

A NON PROFIT CORPORATION

I Andres Martinez, the undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen years or older, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a noncorporation under the laws of the State of Florida, pursuant to Chapter 617.0202 entitled "NonCorporation Act," and the general amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

- 1. The name of the corporation is CENTRO BIBLICO ELIMELEC, INC.
- 2. The corporation is a CHARITABLE & RELIGIOUS corporation whose principal & mailing address is: 775 Harem Ave, Opa-Locka, Fl. 33054
- 3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
 - a. To worship God thru the teaching of his word and worshiping his name.
- b. It is also our purpose to facilitate the tools necessary to help the community with Social Welfare programs which will include the basic areas: the individual, his mind and spirit.
- c. Through food programs for families in need and counseling for persons with behavioral problems within the family and the community.
- d. The purpose for which CENTRO BIBLICO ELIMELEC, INC. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, and/or educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

- e. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- f. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 4. The corporation shall have members which may be divided into such classes as shall be provided in the bylaws. All members shall be accepted, appointed, elected or designated in the manner provided in the bylaws.

The directors of the corporation shall be elected or appointed in the manner and for the terms provided in the Bylaws.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director or member of the corporation; and upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of the residual assets of the corporation exclusively for the stated purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding Sections of any future Internal Revenue Code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, for such purposes or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
