First Article,
Corporate Name:

The name of the corporation shall be Noah's Ark Family Ministries, Incorporated.

Second Article,
Principal Office and Mailing Address:

The principal office of the corporation shall be at 7400 Twenty-first Street North, Saint Petersburg, Florida 33702.

Third Article,
Corporate Purposes:

The corporation is exclusively organized for any and all purposes for which corporations can be organized and operated under Section 501(c)(3) of Title 26, United States Code, including, but not limited to, religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes and for the purpose of preventing cruelty to children.

Fourth Article,
Election of Directors:

The initial directors of the corporation shall be: (1) Frank B. Brunson of 7400 Twenty-first Street North, Saint Petersburg, Florida; (2) Glenda M. Brunson of 7400 Twenty-first Street North, Saint Petersburg, Florida; and (3) Nealya I. Brunson of 7400 Twenty-first Street North, Saint Petersburg, Florida. Thereafter, the number of, method of electing, class(es) of and terms of office for directors shall be specified in the corporate bylaws.

Fifth Article,
Limitations on Corporate Authority:

The corporation shall not engage in any activity prohibited by 501(c)(3) of Title 26, United States Code, including, but not limited to, (a) allowing a substantial part of its activities to involve carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as provided in Section 501(h) of Title 26, United States Code, or (b) participating or intervening in any political campaign, including the publishing or

distributing of statements, on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

**Sixth Article,
Initial Registered Office:**

The registered agent of the corporation shall be Frank B. Brunson and the initial registered office of the corporation shall be at 7400 Twenty-first Street North, Saint Petersburg, Florida 33702.

**Seventh Article,
Incorporator:**

Frank B. Brunson of 7400 Twenty-first Street North, Saint Petersburg, Florida is the incorporator of this corporation.
