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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC

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SECRETARY OF STATE
ALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit Association under the laws of the State of Florida, pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Association, hereinafter referred to as the "Association," shall be DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC. Its principal office and place of business shall be at 905 South Atlantic Avenue, Daytona Beach, Florida 32118, Volusia County, Florida. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office of the Association to any other address in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE II.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

- (1) The Association is formed for the purpose of undertaking all of the functions contained herein and in the Declaration(s) of Condominium for DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT CONDOMINIUM, including but not limited to the Declaration of Condominium for DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT COMDONIMIUM, a condominium, recorded or to be recorded in the Official Record Books of Volusia County, Florida and for the purpose of performing all functions allocated to such Association by Chapter 718 ("Condominium Act") and the applicable provisions of the Florida Vacation Plan and Time-Sharing Act, Chapter 721, Florida Statutes (hereinaster referred to as the "Time-Share Act") and to further own, operate, lease, sell, trade, and otherwise deal with property described in said Declaration(s) in accordance with the provisions of the Condominium Act, Time-Share Act, and said Declaration(s), the Bylaws and these Articles.
- (2) In addition, and not in limitation of the foregoing, although the Developer retains the right to form other condominium associations, the Association is formed for the purpose of being the Association as referred to within each declaration of condominium filed in respect to any condominium located with the Project as defined in the Declaration of Condominium for DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT CONDOMINIUM and any other declaration of condominium relating to the DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT CONDOMINIUM and maintaining, operating and managing the multiple condominium Project containing one or more condominium Developments within the Project established pursuant to the declaration(s) of condominium, therefore from time to time under Chapters 718 and 721, Florida Statutes known as DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT CONDOMINIUM or similar name and located in Volusia County, Florida.

In furtherance of the purposes of the Association, the Association may:

- A. exercise all of the powers and privileges and perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in the afore described Declaration(s) of Condominium as the same may be amended from time to time as therein provided, such Declaration(s) being incorporated herein as if set forth at length:
- B. fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges and assessments pursuant to the terms of said Declaration(s); to pay all expenses in connections therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against any property of the Association;
- C. acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connections with the affairs of the Association;
- D. borrow money, and as appropriate, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;
- E. exercise all of the common law and statutory powers of a corporation not for profit established to govern a Florida condominium; provided, however, that no action shall be taken which conflicts with said Declaration(s), the Condominium Act or the Time-Share Act;
- F. make and enforce reasonable rules and regulations governing the use of Units, Common Elements, Limited Common Elements and any property owned by the Association;
- G. maintain, repair, replace and operate property over which the Association has full ownership or the right and power to maintain, replace and operate in accordance with these Articles, said Declaration(s), the Condominium Act, the Time-Share Act and the Bylaws for this Association;
- H. reconstruct improvements as required in said Declaration(s);
- I. enforce by legal means the provisions of the Condominium Act, Time-Share Act, these Articles, the Bylaws of the Association and the regulations to the use of the property of the Condominium(s);
- J. participate in mergers and consolidations with other not for profit corporations organized for the same or similar purposes;

- K. make and collect assessments against Unit Owners to defray the costs, expenses and losses of the Condominium(s);
- L. use the proceeds of assessments in the exercise of its powers and duties;
- M. maintain, repair, replace and operate the property of the Condominium(s);
- N. purchase insurance upon the property of the Condominium(s) and insurance for the protection of the Association and its members as Unit Owners;
- O. reconstruct the improvements after casualty and to further improve the property;
- P. approve or disapprove the transfer, mortgage and ownership of Units as may be provided in the Declaration(s) of the Condominium and Bylaws;
- Q. contract for the management of the Condominium(s) and to delegate to such contractors all powers and duties of the Association except as such are specifically required by the Declaration(s) of Condominium to have the approval of the Board of Directors or the membership of the Association;
- R. contract for the management or operation of portions of the Common Elements susceptible to separate management or operation, and to lease such portions; and
- S. employ personnel to perform the services required for proper operation of the Condominium(s).

ARTICLE III.

Every person or entity who is the record owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in any Unit or Time-Share Period within the Condominium(s) or any of the multiple Condominiums within the Project, as defined in the Declaration(s), shall be a member of the Association provided, however, each Unit or Time-Share Period, as applicable, shall have only one (1) membership regardless of how many persons own the Unit or Time-Share Period. The foregoing is not intended to include persons or entities owning interest(s) merely as security for the performance of an obligation. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from the ownership of the Unit or Time-Share Period within the Condominium(s) within the Project

All persons who are owners of Condominium Parcels within said Condominium shall automatically be members of this Association. Such membership shall automatically terminate when such person is no longer an Owner of a Condominium Parcel. Membership in the Association shall be limited to such Condominium Parcel Owners.

Persons who own interests in Condominium Parcels under a plan of Time-Share Plan, as defined in the Bylaws of this Association, shall be members of this Association, with their rights and duties to be as defined in the Declaration(s) of Condominium.

Subject to the foregoing, admission to and termination of membership shall be governed by the Declaration(s) of Condominium that shall be filed for said condominium(s) among the Public Records of Lake County, Florida.

ARTICLE IV.

This Association shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V.

The name and residence of the incorporator of these Articles of Incorporation is as follows:

ARTICLE VI.

Section 1.

The affairs of the Association shall be managed and governed by a Board of Directors composed of not less than three (3) nor more than the number specified in the Bylaws. The directors, subsequent to the first Board of Directors, shall be elected at the annual meeting of the membership, for a term of one year, or until their successors shall be elected and shall qualify. Provisions for such election, and provisions respecting the removal, disqualification and resignation of directors and for filling vacancies of the Board of Directors shall be established by the Bylaws.

Section 2.

The principal officers of the Association shall be: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, who shall each be elected from time to time in the manner set forth in the Bylaws adopted by the Association.

ARTICLE VII.

The names of the officers who are to serve until the election of officers, pursuant to the terms of the Declaration of Condominium and Bylaws, are as follows:

The following shall constitute the first Board of Directors and shall serve until the first election of the Board of Directors at the first regular meeting of the membership.

ARTICLE IX.

The Bylaws of the Association shall initially be made and adopted by its first Board of Directors.

Prior to the time the Declaration of Condominium for DOUBLE STAY INN RESORT CONDOMINIUM is filed in the Public Records of Volusia County, Florida, said first Board of Directors shall have full power to amend, alter or rescind said Bylaws by a majority vote.

After the aforesaid Declaration of Condominium is so filed, the Bylaws may be amended, altered, supplemented or modified by the membership at the annual meeting, or at a duly convened special meeting of the membership, by vote, as follows:

- A. If the proposed change has been approved by the unanimous approval of the Board of Directors, then it shall require only a majority vote of the total membership to be adopted.
- B. If the proposed change has not been approved by the unanimous vote of the Board of Directors, then the proposed change must be approved by 75% of the total vote of the membership.

ARTICLE X.

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by any member or Director, and shall be adopted in the same manner as is provided for the amendment of the Bylaws as set forth in Article IX above. Said amendment(s) shall be effective when a copy thereof, together with an attached certificate of approval by the membership, sealed, with the corporate seal, signed by the Secretary or an Assistant Secretary, and executed and acknowledged by the President or Vice President, has been filed with the Secretary of State, State of Florida, and all filing fees paid.

ARTICLE XI.

This Association shall have all of the powers set forth in Section 617.021, Florida Statutes, all of the powers set forth in the Condominium Act and the applicable provisions of the Florida Time-Share Act, and all powers granted to it by the Declaration of Condominium and exhibits annexed thereto, including the power to contract for the management of the Condominium and its recreational facilities.

ARTICLE XII.

There shall be no dividends paid to any of the members, not shall any part of the income of the Association be distributed to its Board of Directors or officers. In the event there are any excess receipts over disbursements as a result of performing services, such excess shall be applied against future expenses. The Association may pay compensation in a reasonable amount to its members, directors and officers for services rendered, may confer benefits upon its members in conformity with its purposes, and upon dissolution or liquidation, may make distribution it its members as is permitted by the court having jurisdiction thereof, and no such payment, benefit or distribution shall be deemed to be a dividend or distribution of income.

This Association shall issue no shares of stock of any kind or nature whatsoever. Membership in the Association and the transfer thereof, as well as the number of members, shall be upon such terms and conditions as provided for in the Declaration of Condominium(s) and Bylaws. The voting rights of the Owners of Parcels in said Condominium Property shall be as set forth in the Declaration of Condominium(s) and/or Bylaws.

ARTICLE XIII.

The street address of the initial registered office of this Association is 905 South Atlantic Avenue, Daytona Beach, Volusia County, Florida 32118, and the name of the initial registered agent of this Association at that address is William W. Tarmann.

ARTICLE XIV.

Fifteen percent (15%) of the members entitled to vote, represented in person or by proxy, shall constitute a quorum at a meeting of members. The affirmative vote of a majority of the members represented at the meeting at which a quorum is present, and entitled to vote on the subject matter, shall be the act of the members, unless the vote of a greater number is required by these Articles or the Bylaws.

ARTICLE XV.

Section 1. Powers

The Association shall levy and collect adequate Assessments against members of the Association for the cost of maintenance and operation of any surface water or storm water management system applicable to the Condominium(s) Property.

Section 2. Assessments

The Assessments as referenced above shall be used for the maintenance and repair of the surface water or storm water management systems including but not limited to work within retention areas, drainage structures and drainage easements.

Section 3. Dissolution

In the event of termination, dissolution or final liquidation of the Association, the responsibility for the operation and maintenance of any surface water or storm water management system applicable to the Condominium(s) Property must be transferred to an accepted by an entity which would comply with relevant law including, if applicable, Section 40C-42.027, F.A.C., and be approved by any applicable water management district prior to such termination, dissolution or liquidation.
