

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HISTORIC BARTOW, INC.



We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a corporation not-forprofit under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is: HISTORIC BARTOW, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, literary, or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code), including all activities necessary, suitable or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment or attainment thereof. 
