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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NEW WINE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY, INC. (COMUNIDAD CRISTIANA VINO NUEVO, INC.)

A Florida Non-Profit Corporation



ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be: New Wine Christian Community, Inc (Comunidad Cristiana Vino Nuevo, Inc.).

ARTICLE II STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE

This is a non-profit corporation organized solely for religious purposes pursuant to the Florida Nor For Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The specific and primary purpose for which this corporation is formed is to engage in the religious activities, by the distribution of it's finds for such purposes and particularly for religious purposes. The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such religious purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations qualifying as tax-exempt organizations under that code. This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of it's activities, carry out propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the board of directors. Any person meeting the requirements for membership, as provided for in the bylaws, and agreeing to be bound by the articles of incorporation of this corporation, by it's bylaws, and by such rules and regulations as the directors may from time to time adopt, is eligible for membership in the corporation. The directors shall from time to time prescribe the form and manner in which application may be made for membership.

ARTICLE VI LOCATION OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE, INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND NAME OF INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT.

ARTICLE IX MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

(a) Board of Directors: The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, it's properties controlled and it's affairs conducted by a board of directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be five, provided, however, that such number may be changed by a bylaw duly adopted by the members.

The directors named in Article VII shall hold office until such time as an election of directors shall be held.

Directors elected at the first annual meeting, and at all ties thereafter, shall serve for a term of one year until the annual meeting of members following the election of directors and until the qualification of the successors in office. Annual meetings shall be held at 6:00 p.m. on the first Monday in September of each year at the principal office of the corporation, or at such other time and place as the Board of Directors may designate from time to time by resolution.

(b) Corporate Officers: The board of directors shall elect the following officers: President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary and Asst. Secretary; and such other officers as the bylaws of this corporation may authorize the directors to elect from time to time. Such officers shall be initially elected at the first annual meeting of the board of directors. Until such election is held, the following persons shall serve as corporate officers:

ARTICLE X DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution or liquidation of this corporation, it's assets remaining after payment of or providing for all liabilities, contingent or otherwise, will be disposed or distributed exclusively for religious purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, in accordance with the decision of the board of directors of this corporation. Any assets not so disposed of or distributed by the board of directors, or the proper court with jurisdiction, will be disposed or distributed exclusively to such organization(s), to be determined by the court, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. This article shall override any laws of the State of Florida establishing a different scheme of distribution or disposition or empowering a court to establish a different scheme of distribution or disposition.

ARTICLE XI LIMITATION OF POWERS

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles or state law, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE XII INDEMNIFICATION OF DIRECTORS

In order to induce officers or directors of the corporation to serve or continue to serve as such, the corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless each person who heretofore has served or shall serve at any time hereafter as a director or officer of the corporation, and any person who serves at the request of this corporation as a director or officer of any other corporation, from and against any and all claims and liabilities to which such person shall become subject by reason of his having heretofore or hereafter been a director or officer of the corporation, or by reason of any action alleged to have been heretofore or hereafter taken or omitted by him as such director or officer, and shall reimburse each such person for all legal and other expenses reasonably incurred by him in connection with any such claim or liability; provided that no person shall be indemnified against, or be reimbursed for any expenses incurred in connection with claim or liability as to which it shall be adjudged that such officer or director is liable for willful misconduct in the performance of his duties. The board of directors is hereby authorized to obtain directors and officers liability insurance covering acts heretofore and hereafter occurring and to pay for same from funds of the corporation. The rights accruing to any person under the foregoing provisions shall not exclude any other right to which he may be lawfully entitled, nor shall anything herein contained restrict the right of the corporation to indemnify or reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specifically herein provided for.
