ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WOMAN THOU ART LOSE OUTREACH INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of WOMEN TO WOMAN WORLDWIDE

OUTREACH MINISTRIES, INC. for the purpose of creating a non corporation under the laws
of the State of FLORIDA as contained in ARTRICLE OF CORPORATION entitled "Non

Corporation Act," and the general amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

ARTICLE I. NAME

WOMAN TO WOMAN WORLDWIDE OUTREACH MINISTRIES, INC.

The corporation is a RELIGIOUS corporation.

ARTICLE II. ADDRESS

ARTICLE III DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT

The corporation will exist perpetually, commencing on the date of filing of these Articles in Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

The corporationis organized as a corportion not for profit, exclusively for charitabel, religious, educational, and scientific purpose within the meanin of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including but not limited to providing disadantaged person with (i) economic assistance, (ii) goods and services relating to basic human needs, (iii) training, education and support in regard to the physcial, emotional, spiritual, and financial needs of such person.

- a. TO MINISTER AND PROVIDE SERVICES TOO BROKEN HEARTED, ABUSED, WOMEN, CHILDREN AND TEEN MOTHERS FROM ALL AREAS. SUCH AS DRUGS, AIDS, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND PROVERTY.
- b. TO PROVIDE CHRISTIAN COUNSELING, THERAPY ALONG WITH MENTAL
- c. TO PROVIDE AN OUTREACH MINISTRY TO THE COMMUNITY, SHELTER, DENTIONS CENTERS, SUBSTANCE ABUSE AGENCY JAILS AND PRISIONS.

ARTICLE V. LIMITATIONS ON CORPORATE POWER

The Corporate powers of the corporationare as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, except to the extent such powers are limited by the followings provisions of this Article:

- (a) No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (b) The corporation shall have members which may be divided into such classes as shall be provided in the bylaws. All members shall be accepted, appointed, elected or designated in the manner provided in the bylaws.
- (c) The directors of the corporation shall be elected or appointed in the manner and for the terms provided in the Bylaws.
- (d) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director or member of the corporation; and upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of the residual assets of the corporation exclusively for the stated purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding Sections of any future Internal Revenue Code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, for such purposes or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERS

The qualification for members and the manner of their admission will be provided in the bylaws. the rights exercisable by members will also be as provided in the bylaws. The member will elect directors at the first annanual meeting of members and at each annual meeting therafter.

ARTICLE VII. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The corporation designates 4129 Emerson Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32207 as the street address of the initial registered office of the corporation and Joan Bellamy-Waters as the initial registered agent at the address to accept service of process within this state.
