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### RIDER A

ARTICLE III is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

### "ARTICLE III

The purpose for which this not-for-profit corporation is formed and objectives to be carried on and promoted by it, are as follows:

- (A) To receive and maintain a fund or funds of real and personal property, or both, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom and the principal thereof exclusively to become a world authority on heart failure treatment innovations, including heart replacement therapy, through the funding of research, education and prevention programs to reduce deaths from heart failure, the creation of an environment in which future healers in heart failure may be educated, and the improvement of customer service for heart failure patients. Support shall be made either by direct payment or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- (B) To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon corporations not-for-profit.
- (C) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- (D) The Corporation shall serve only such purposes and functions and shall engage only in such services as are consonant with the purposes set forth in this Article III and as are exclusively charitable and are entitled to exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
- (E) To do such things as are incidental to the purposes of the corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them."
