ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SIDEKICK FOUNDATION, INC. (A Non-Profit Corporation)

The undersigned incorporator, in order to form a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation is SIDEKICK FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 8210 Wiles Road, Coral Springs, Florida 33067.

ARTICLE III: DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV: PURPOSES

- (a) This corporation is organized and formed exclusively for general charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). At all times, including upon dissolution, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed for an exempt purpose.
- (b) The purpose of this corporation shall be to provide relief to the distressed and/or the underprivileged by: (i) increasing awareness of the benefits of martial arts training to improve mental and physical health; (ii) providing scholarships for training; and (iii) the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the

Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

None of the earnings of this corporation shall inure to any private shareholder or (c)

individual.

(d) This corporation shall not influence legislation as a substantial part of its activities,

or participate at all in campaign activity for or against political candidates.

(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not

carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal

income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are

deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

(f) In any taxable year in which this corporation is a private foundation as described in

Section 509(a) of the Code, the corporation: (i) shall distribute its income for said period at such

time and manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Code; (ii) shall not engage in

any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941 of the Code; (iii) shall not retain any excess

business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code; (iv) shall not make any investments

in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code; and (v) shall not

make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code.

ARTICLE V: MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS
