ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EXPERIENCE THE DREAM, INC

Document Number N00000007978

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments Adopted

- 1. The words of Article III (b), reading as follows: "To engage in charitable, benevolent, eleemosynary and civic activities, but not for pecuniary profit;" are deleted, and replaced by the following words: "The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code."
- 2. The following words are added to Article IV: "Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."

SECOND: Date of Adoption

The date of adoption of the amendments was January 11, 2002.

THIRD: Adoption of Amendment

There are no members or members entitled to vote on the amendments. The amendments were adopted by the board of directors.
