I am writing to request the waving of reinstatement fees for two corporations that I am president of. They are **Florida Modern Pentathlon & Fencing Corp.** EIN – 59-3712778 a for profit corporation for instructing children and adults in the art and history of the sport of fencing, and **Florida Modern Pentathlon and Fencing Foundation Inc.** EIN – 59-3686174 a non profit corporation for providing the financial resources to promote education and the teaching and history of the sport-of-fencing in the-State-of-Florida.

I may be a great teacher as the students and parents and coaches say but in the face of family disaster I cant fence my way out of a paper bag.
