

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 01 MAY 29 PM 12: 22

OF

HIALEAH MIAMI SPRINGS ROTARY CHARITABLE FUNDATION, INC. A Not-for-Profit Corporation

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

Article One should be amended to change the name of the not-FIRST: for-profit corporation to HIALEAH-MIAMI SPRINGS ROTARY CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC., a not-for-profit corporation.

Article Three should be amended to include the following, to SECOND: wit:

- Said corporation/organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).
- No part of the net earnings of the corporation/organization (b) shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distribution in furtherance of section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities not to carried bу on (a) corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

(c) Upon dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

THIRD: The date of adoption of the amendments was May 2, 2001.

FOURTH: Adoption of the amendments is adopted by the board of directors, and there are no members entitled to vote on the amendments.
