ARTICLE I

The Name of the corporation is Rescue and Recovery Mission, Inc. located at 2213 Cleveland Street, Hollywood, FL 33020.

ARTICLE II

The term of existence of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law. The Corporate existence shall commence at the time of filing with the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation may transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Laws of the United States and the State of Florida. The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is to provide disadvantaged people and non-profit/not-for-profit organizations in urban, suburban and rural communities, particularly depressed and/or environmentally blighted areas, with services relative to charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families towards a life of self sufficiency. These programs will consist of, but will not be limited to job training, job placement, land acquisition, housing, employment, literacy, counseling, temporary shelter, teenage pregnancy, substance abuse awareness and prevention, tutoring, AIDS education and prevention, elderly care and other programs to aid those in need.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the

organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax code.

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall never have less than three (3) Directors. The business affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by a minimum of three (3) officers/directors, each of who shall be of full age, and all of who shall be citizens of the United States.


