ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

For

Victory is Your's Ministries, Inc.

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a corporation exclusively for charitable purposes, under the provisions of chapter 617 of the Florida statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is Victory is Your's Ministries, Inc. and its place of business is 335 Griffin Avenue, Lakeland, Florida 33801.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

The qualifications of members and the manner of their admission shall be as provided in the by-laws.

ARTICLE IV

EXISTENCE

This corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing as of the date of execution of these articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE V

REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

AMENDEMENTS AND BY LAWS

This corporation shall not carry on propaganda, or otherwise act to influence legislation or participate in political campaigns as a substantial part of its activities. No part of the income of the corporation shall be paid or inure to the benefit of any person within the corporation.

ARTICLE VII

INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ARTICLE VIII

NON-PROFIT

The corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and may confer benefits upon its members in conformity with its purposes.

ARTICLE IX

TAX EXEMPT STATUS

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under IRS section 501©(3) (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future internal revenue law.)

ARTICLE X

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of IRC section 501©(3) or corresponding sections of any future federal tax code or be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

INDEMNIFICATION

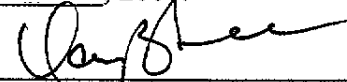

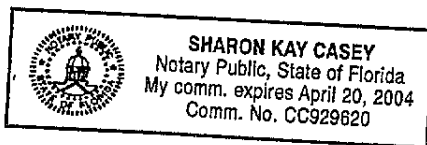
