ARTICLE III PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS

A. The manner in which the initial fifteen (15) directors, but not more than thirty-five (35) are appointed is in accordance with section 411.01, ss.(5) Creation of Early Learning Coalitions

- 1. Department of Children and Family Services District Administrator
- 2. District Superintendent of Schools
- 3. Regional Workforce Board Executive board chair or director
- 4. County Health Department director or his or her designee.
- 5. A children's services council or juvenile welfare board chair or executive director, if applicable
- 6. A child care licensing agency head
- 7. A president of a community college or his or her designee
- 8. One member appointed by a board of county commissioners
- 9. A central agency administrator
- 10. A Head Start director
- 11. A representative of private child care providers
- 12. A representative of faith-based child care providers
- 13. A representative of programs for children with disabilities under the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act

The Governor shall appoint the chair and two other private-sector members. The Vice Chair shall be elected by a majority of the voting members of the coalition.

More than one-third of the coalition members must be from the private sector, and neither they nor their families may earn an income form the early education and child care industry. To meet this requirement, the coalition must appoint additional members from a list of nominees submitted to the coalition by the chambers of commerce or economic development councils within the geographic area of the coalition.

- B. Each coalition member shall serve a term of four years.
- C. Any vacancies occurring on the board shall be filled in the following manner:
 - 1. Where a director to be replaced is assigned pursuant to statute, the chairperson shall make a formal request to the statutory agency to replace the director.
 - 2. Where a director to be replaced is not assigned pursuant to statute, the nominating committee shall receive applications for membership from qualified candidates to be presented to the board for approval.
- D. Method of election of officers is as stated in the bylaws
- E. All members shall abide by Florida's Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees in Chapter 112 (Part IIII) of the Florida Statutes.
