(Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Fkorida Non-Profit Corporation adopts the following Articles of amendment to its Articles of Incorporation)

FIRST: Amendments(s) adopted.

ARTICLE 111: PURPOSE OF THE CORPORATION AMENDMENT

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes and consists of the following:

- To aid and assist low-income, poor and disadvantaged individuals and families residing
 within all counties of the State of Florida towards a life of self-sufficiency by establishing
 structured support services, constructing and renovating housing, providing opportunities
 for land acquisition and affordable, low-cost housing for low and middle income families.
- To expand opportunities available to said residents and groups to obtain adequate low-cost housing accommodations and constructing, rehabilitating, and providing decent, safe and sanitary housing in target area(s) for persons and families of low-income who otherwise would not be able to find or to afford a suitable place to live. It is the purpose of the corporation to lessen the burdens of government and to promote social welfare. To provide such housing rehabilitation of existing substandard buildings, construction and management of new facilities in the place of blighted structures of blighted vacant sites for the purpose of combating the deterioration of the community and by contributing to its physical environment. Nothing in the descriptive purpose is intended to preclude the corporation from forming a Community Development Corporation (CDC) and/or a Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO).
- 3) To aid, support and provide services through general contributions and funding from other corporations, foundations, state and federal agencies for programs that will consist of but shall not be limited to: Literacy, Job Training and Job Placement, Economic Empowerment Home Ownership and Home Ownership Counseling Programs, Computer Training Programs, Teenage Pregnancy and Prevention, Substance Abuse Awareness and Prevention, After School Programs, Children's Home and Homes for Unwed Mothers, Remedial Educational Programs, Youth At-Risk Programs, AIDS/HIV Care and Prevention, Senior Citizens Programs, Family and Children Services, Individual, Group and Family Counseling.

(4) To include the organization in the creation of nursing homes, Adult Congregate Living Facilities (ACLF), Day Care and Early Learning Facilities, including the development of low to moderate income homes for those residents whose income represent 40% of the median income for the target areas; 45% of the median income for the target areas; 50% of the median income for the target areas; that the Board of Directors may approve.
