ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF
THE CARPENTER'S CHRISTIAN CHURCH, INC.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of the undersigned, a whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation State of Florida, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

NAME OF BUSINESS: The name of the proposed corporation shall be THE CARPENTER'S CHRISTIAN CHURCH, INC.

ARTICLE II

The place in this state where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is: 1116 Country Club Road, St. Petersburg, Pinellas County, Florida 33710.

ARTICLE III

NATURE OF BUSINESS: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

TRUSTEES: The Trustees of the corporation shall be elected by a majority vote of the voting members of the congregation or appointed by a majority of the elders of the congregation. The number of Trustees of this corporation shall be no more than five (5) and no less than three (3) Trustees.

ARTICLE V

The names and addresses of the Trustees who shall hold office for the first year of existence of the corporation or until a successor or successors are elected or appointed and who have qualified are:

ARTICLE VI.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(1) of the internal revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VIII

REGISTERED AGENT AND REGISTERED OFFICE: The Carpenter's Christian Church designates JAMES MICHAEL HARGRAVE, as the Registered Agent and also establishes 1116 Country Clug Road, St. Petersburg, Florida 33710, as its Registered Office within the State of Florida, pursuant to Section 607.164 Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE IX

SUBSCRIBER: The name and address of the Subscriber of this corporation is: Bonnie J. Bracewell, 8867 Briarwood Drive, Seminole, Florida 33772.

ARTICLE X

TERM OF EXISTENCE: This corporation shall have a perpetual term of existence, commencing upon receipt of these Articles by the Secretary of State.

Having been named as Registered Agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
