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

Pursuant to the provisions of section 607.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

FIRST: Amendment adopted: Addition of

**ARTICLE VII
DISSOLUTION**


On dissolution of the Corporation, all of its net assets shall be paid over or transferred to one or more exempt organizations of the kind described in Internal Revenue Code Section 501 (c) (3). The organization to receive such property shall be designated by the board of directors. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court in and for the County of Pinellas exclusively for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code Section 501 (c) (3), or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the above amendment is May 24, 2001.

THIRD: The amendment was adopted by a unanimous vote of the board of directors.

FOURTH: There are no members entitled to vote in this organization.
