Articles Of Incorporation

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt (s) the following Articles Of Incorporation.

Article I Name

Article III Purposes (s)

The specific purpose (s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

1. To serve as a funding agent to support all Glades area [Pahokee, Belle Glade, South Bay and surrounding Glades area sports and recreational activities. Including baseball, softball, soccer, tennis, golf, track and field, volleyball, football, gymnastics, cheerleading, fishing etc.
2. Provide professional training in the above sports to Glades Tri-city and surrounding Glades cities youth by providing training camps. Manned by professional athletes from various professional sports clubs [NBA, NFL, PGA, ATP, ASA, USSA, AAU, USA, MSI,]
3. To provide funding for equipment and supply purchases, participants insurance coverage, volunteer insurance coverage, office supplies, supplies and equipment for concession sales, rental of storage facility, participant awards, officials stipend, and transportation cost and maintenance.
