DISSOLUTION CLAUSE

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization(s) organized and operated exclusively for the charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization(s) under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of Duval County, Florida exclusively for the purposes or to such organization(s), as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
