ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

Original Articles

No reference to purposes of corporation being exclusively charitable and educational

Amendment

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ADDITION OF ARTICLE V POWERS

Original Articles

No paragraph on the activities of organization precluded by IRS 501 (c) (3)

Addition of ARTICLE V POWERS

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ADDITION OF ARTICLE VI DISSOLUTION

Original Articles

No paragraph on the event of dissolution of the organization

Addition of ARTICLE VI DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c) (3) and 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.
