The undersigned, constituting all of the current members of the Board of Directors of American Adoptions of Florida, Inc., a Florida corporation (the "Company"), hereby approve in writing this Resolution and Plan of Dissolution and Distribution of Assets (the "Resolution"):

- 2. **Dissolution.** The Company desires to be and shall be dissolved pursuant to Florida Stat. § 617.1402, effective September 1, 2016.
- 3. **Discharge of or Adequate Provision for Liabilities and Obligations**.
