Pursuant to sections 617.1001, 617.1002, and 617.1006 of the Florida Statutes, Moffitt Morton Plant Cancer Care Network, Inc., a Florida nonprofit corporation, adopts the following Articles of Amendment (the "Amendment") to amend its Articles of Incorporation:

1. Name of Corporation. The name of the corporation is Moffitt Morton Plant Cancer Care Network, Inc. (the "Corporation").
2. Text of Amendment. Article I is deleted in its entirety and substituted with the following:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be MOFFITT MORTON PLANT
CANCER CARE, INC.

3. Date of Adoption. The Amendment was adopted to be effective March 21, 2001.
4. Manner of Adoption. The Amendment was adopted by unanimous written consent of all of the Members to be effective as of March 21, 2001. The numbers of votes cast in favor of the Amendment was sufficient for adoption.
