

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

DAVIDA ASSOCIATION, INC.

A corporation not for profit



ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be DAVIDA ASSOCIATION, INC., a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The mailing address of this corporation shall be 12640 N.W. 12 Court, Sunrise, FL 33323.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation shall be to assist and improve the lives of poverty stricken handicapped and sick children in the small town of La Tebaida, Colombia, South America. The Association shall continue in its efforts to offer educational and health care programs as well as workshops to the handicapped children.

ARTICLE IV - QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS

Any person that is actively involved by volunteering their time and effect in the Association may become a member.

ARTICLE VIII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTIONS

The Board of Directors shall be elected by the membership at each annual meeting of the members.

ARTICLE IX - OFFICERS

The legal affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the officers who shall be elected at the annual meeting each year to serve for the ensuing year. The officers of the corporation shall serve until their respective successors in office shall be elected and duly qualified.

ARTICLE X - REVENUE

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its Members, Directors, Officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonablecompensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. The corporation shall not in any way, directly or indirectly, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt $t\overline{o}$ influence legislation, or participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, by publishing or distributing statements or otherwise. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue_Law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986_(or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

ARTICLE XI - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as_an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
