**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**ARTICLE I**

**NAME**

The name of this Foundation is : The H.O.P.E. Outreach Foundation, Incorporated.  
The Principal and Mailing address is: 1024 So. 78th Street, Tampa,  
Florida 33619

**ARTICLE II**  
**DURATION**

The term of existence of this Foundation shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE III**

**PURPOSES**

The general nature, object and purposes of this Foundation shall be :

- (a) For the establishing, managing and funding of Humanitarian Projects such as; Disaster Relief , Feeding The Needy, Caring For Those Designated As Homeless, Caring For The Disenfranchised, and The Support Of Church Organizations That This Foundation Deems Appropriate. These herein shall be determined by the Board Of Trustees of this Foundation.
- (b) To Participate and Aid organizations involved in Humanitarian, Christian Outreach And Evangelism.
- (c) This Foundation shall be a wholly Charitable Foundation.
- (d) To acquire by conveyance or inheritance – whether by gift or purchase- real property, personal property and mixed real and personal property, to be received and held in trust for the use and benefit of this Foundation and it's stated purposes.
- (e) To improve, invest, sell, lease, assign, mortgage or otherwise encumber any such Property, when such action is deemed in the best interests of this Foundation as defined in it's stated purposes aforesaid as a Charitable Foundation.

- (f) To engage in and operate Archaeological and Historic expeditions and digs and to Recover, display, preserve such findings for historic and religious posterity.
- (g) To solicit funds for each special project concerning the purposes aforesaid of this Foundation.

#### ARTICLE IV

##### POWERS

- (1.) To accomplish the foregoing purposes, the Foundation shall have all corporate power Permitted under Federal laws and of the laws of the State of Florida, including the legal capacity-as an Independent entity – to enter into contracts and to prosecute and defend against actions at law or equity.
- (2.) This Foundation is specifically precluded from engaging in any prohibited activities, Deviating from it's general purpose.

#### ARTICLE V

##### AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Upon the proper notification to the Directors/ Trustees of this Foundation, Amendments to these Articles may be proposed and adopted upon a two-thirds (2/3 rds) vote of the Board Of Directors/Trustees present at any regular meeting or any special meeting called for that purpose.

#### ARTICLE VI

- (a) The business affairs of this Foundation shall be managed by and under the direction And supervision of the three (3) Directors/Trustees as set forth in the By-Laws of this Foundation which shall be considered the Executive Board.
- (b) The Board Of Directors of this Foundation shall provide such By- Laws for the Conduct of it's business and the carrying out of it's purposes as they deem necessary .

- (c) Upon proper notice, the By- Laws may be amended, altered or rescinded upon a Two- thirds (2/3rds) vote of the members of the Board Of Directors present at any Regular meeting or special meeting called for that purpose.

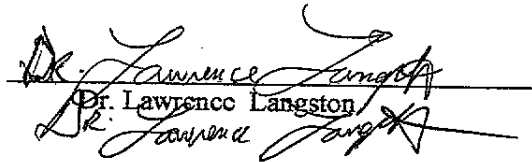
- (a) The above officers shall be the Directors and Trustees of this Foundation.
- (b) All Directors and Trustees shall be elected or appointed annually at the annual meeting of this Foundation which shall be the first Monday of March every year at a time and place prescribed in the By- Laws. Said Officers and Directors shall assume their duties and responsibilities at the first meeting following appointment.
- (c) A majority of the Directors shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the directors.

## ARTICLE IX

Pursuant to Florida Law, this Foundation has named Dr. Lawrence Langston as it's registered agent to accept service of process within this State. The registered office of said agent shall be ; 1024 South 78<sup>th</sup> Street, Tampa, Florida 33619.

## ARTICLE X

### LIMITATIONS AND DISSOLUTION

- (a) This Foundation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific Purposes of the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 c 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 ( or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law.)
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this Foundation will not carry on Other activities not permitted to be carried on;
  - (1.) A Foundation or Corporation exempt from federal income tax under sections 501 © 3 of the Internal revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law ; OR  
  
A Foundation or Corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 107 © (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law.
- (c) In the event of Dissolution, the residual assets of the Foundation will be turned over to a Foundation or Organization of like purpose which is duly incorporated and operating under the same provisions which is in accordance with and described in sections 501© 3 and 107 © 2 of the Internal Revenue Law. This organization must be approved by the Board of Directors / Trustees by a majority vote.
