ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I - NAME

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III - PURPOSES

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

- 1. To bring unity to the veterans organizations of Lee County and other veteran organization members thereby establishing Unity of Purpose by providing a single voice to communicate veteran's viewpoints and a means of disseminating information on issues before local, state or national legislative bodies which affect veterans, their families and surviving spouses.
- 2. To plan, cooperate and coordinate with local authorities, government officials, and other interested parties on matters of patriotic celebrations, parades, events and other social functions.
- 3. To plan, coordinate and implement any other programs, including those of civic and private agencies, to serve the best interest of the U.S. military forces, veterans, dependents, surviving spouses and dependent children.
- 4. To cooperate with local, state and national social services and welfare agencies in programs relating to the welfare of veterans, military personnel and their dependents.
- 5. To develop, plan and execute fund raising programs to raise funds for the general purposes of assisting veterans and their families in need, homeless veterans and their dependents, and for specific purposes benefiting veterans, U.S. military personnel and their families.

- 6. To bring together individual veterans to participate in informal presentations to the area schools so as to teach the values of patritism, sacrifices and what our military forces mean to the security and welfare of all of our citizens.
- 7. Where feasible and practical, coordinate the major social functions of member veterans organizations including publicity and other public awareness programs.

This corporation shall be a NOT FOR PROFIT corporation.

ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS and BY-LAWS

The initial Board of Directors, as set forth in Article V herein below, shall serve until a new Board is elected. The Directors shall be elected by the Membership at its annual meeting. The corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors.

By-laws for the corporation shall be adopted by the Board within thirty days from the date of incorporation.
