ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE BLACKMAN FIRE DISTRICT, INC.

We the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida applicable to Corporations Not For Profit, and respectfully petition the Secretary of State for approval of such incorporation under the following proposed Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Blackman Fire District, Inc., and is to be located in the general vicinity of Blackman, Okaloosa County, Florida, as defined in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

<u>ARTICLE II</u>

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business shall be located at 1850 Hwy 2, Baker, FL 32531; however, the mailing address shall be: C/O 2107 Hwy 2, Baker, FL 32531.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The general nature of the objective of this corporation shall be to provide a volunteer fire department for the Blackman area, in Okaloosa County, Florida, to include the housing of fire-fighting equipment, the storage and maintenance of fire-fighting equipment, the organization of a volunteer fire department, the training of personnel, and to work to the general end of reducing fire hazards and to combat fires in said area.

ARTICLE IV

ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The initial Board of Directors, listed in Article V, shall hold and remain in office until their successors are elected and qualified in the next general election following the year 2000, unless such Director ceases to be qualified to act or is removed for cause. In said general election, three (3) Directors shall be elected for four (4) year terms and two (2) Directors shall be elected for two (2) year terms. The three (3) candidates attaining the highest number of votes shall be elected for the four (4) year terms and the two (2) candidates receiving the next highest number of votes will be elected for two (2) year terms. In subsequent elections, each Director shall be elected for a term of four (4) years. They shall qualify for office in the same manner as is provided for other general county officers. In the event any commissioner ceases to be qualified to act through resignation, removal for cause, other compelling reason, or due to the failure of any candidates to qualify for the office, the vacancy thereby created shall be filled by appointment by the majority of the remaining members of the Board of Directors until the expiration of the term of the member who has become disqualified or failed to qualify for office.

ARTICLE V

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The corporation shall me managed by a Board of Directors consisting of five (5) persons, and the following persons shall serve as directors until the first election thereof:
