ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MINORITY WOMEN'S CRISIS RESOURCE CENTER, INC.

(A Florida Corporation not-for-profit)



The name of the Corporation shall be MINORITY WOMEN'S CRISIS RESOURCE CENTER, INC.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS.

The street address and the initial principal place of business of the corporation shall be 8175 Durand Avenue, Pensacola, Florida 32505. The mailing address shall be the same.

ARTICLE III: CORPORATE PURPOSES AND POWERS.

The Corporation is organized to operate a minority women's crisis resource center. The Mission Statement is as follows:

A non-profit organization dedicated to finding and/or providing resources to assist minority women in crisis situations establish stability, empowering them to become self-sufficient members of society.

The Minority Women's Crisis Resource Center will provide services to encourage self determination, cooperation and attention to the needs of the body, mind and spirit.

Subject to the limitations otherwise set forth in these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall have all of the powers, privileges and rights necessary or convenient for carrying out the purposes for which the Corporation is formed, and the Directors hereby claim for the Corporation all the benefits, privileges, rights and powers created, given, extended or conferred by all applicable laws of the State of Florida, and of the United States pertaining to not-for-profit corporations and any additions or amendments thereto.

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ARTICLE VI: DIRECTORS.

The Corporation shall initially have five (5) Directors. The Board of Directors shall be responsible for carrying out the directives and mandates of the crisis resource center. Elections shall be in June of each election year. The term and method of election of the Board of Directors shall be as stated in the by-laws.
